

- 5 marks shall be allotted for each correct answer and 2 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer or if the team doesn't know the answer after they press the Buzzer.
- There will be no forwarding of questions after hitting the buzzer.
- Answering time is only 30 seconds per question.
- In case of tie among teams, there shall be 3 bonus questions to break the tie.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- The registration fee for the competition shall be Rs. 200/- per participant which shall be paid along with the duly filled registration form marked as Annexure-I.

PURPOSE

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- **Competitive Level** - Participation is open for all law students pursuing LL.B., LL.M., Diploma, PhD or any other allied degree in the academic year 2018-19 from any recognized law school / college / university in India. Even the pass-outs are eligible to participate.
- **Under Graduate Level** - Participation is open only for all law students pursuing any three or five year courses of the LL.B degree in the academic year 2018-19 from any recognized law school/ college/ university in India are eligible to participate. Both the participants should be enrolled in same institute.

THEME

The broad theme for the said competition is "NATIONAL QUIZ COMPETITION - 2018." i.e., 1st Quiz Competition for Law students.

- The entry of participants will be from Gate No. 2 of ITM University, Sithouli Campus.
- The list of the participants will be provided to the gate authorities for their smooth entry.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES FOR THE COMPETITION

1. Only individual entries are eligible for competitive Level and Team Entry are eligible for Under Graduate Level.
2. There is no bar on number of participants from a single institution.
3. The decision of the organizing committee will be final and will not be subject to any change.
4. The participants shall not be allowed to use notes, books, bare acts, handwritten material, mobile, laptops or other electronic gadgets, etc.
5. Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
6. Any kind of unfair means or non-adherence to the rules during the competition shall result in disqualification of the candidate immediately.
7. The organizers reserve the right to vary, alter, modify, or repeal any of the rules, if so required, as they deem fit.
8. In no case, shall the registration amount be refunded.
9. In case of any dispute or difficulty arising out of or during the course of competition, the organizing committee shall have the sole and absolute authority to remove such difficulty and resolve the dispute.
10. The organizers reserve the absolute right to cancel, defer or postpone indefinitely, the competition in the event of the accruing of any such incident, natural or man caused.
11. The participants must take care of their belongings at all times, the University shall not be responsible for any loss or theft of the same under any circumstances.
12. Once the registration amount is paid by the participants, and the participants intend to withdraw from the said competition or are unable to participate in the competition, the organizing University shall have the sole discretion to refund the registration fee after due considerations.

STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION

Competitive Level -

- The questions will be asked in the form of Multiple Choice Questions, comprising 100 questions of Constitutional Law, Civil Procedure Code 1908, Criminal Procedure Code 1973, Indian Evidence Act 1872, Indian Penal Code 1860 and Law of Contract 1872.
- Time duration:- 90 Minutes
- 2 marks will be awarded for each right answer, and there will be no negative marking for wrong answer.
- The competition shall be bilingual i.e., Hindi and English

Under Graduate Level -

Preliminary Round

- The questions will be asked in the form of Multiple Choice Questions, comprising 100 questions of Constitutional Law and Law of Contract i.e., 70 and 30 respectively.
- Time duration:- 90 Minutes
- 2 marks will be awarded for each right answer, and there will be no negative marking for wrong answer.
- The Competition shall only be in English Language.

Final Round

- This will be a Buzzer Round. A question will be fired & the team who presses the buzzer first gets to answer first. Comprising 51 Questions of Constitutional Law and Law of Contract.
- Top eight teams will qualify for final round. However, this is subject to change at the discretion of the organizing committee.
- Top 8 teams shall reach for the final round.
